**Reconciliation** Confessions are heard Saturdays, 9am & 4pm or by appointment.



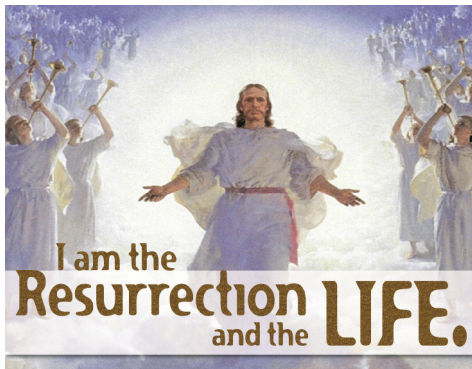
## Divine Mercy Devotion

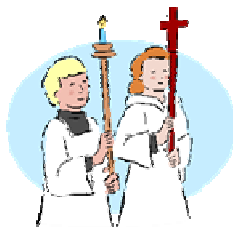
